<u>Who is the course for?</u>



All students: This is an activity based course. Students will develop skills which are needed by Health and Social Care professionals.

What will I learn?

BTEC Tech Award in Health and Social Care is divided into 3 components.

- Component 1– Human Lifespan and Development. This Unit looks at how humans develop and change from birth to death and how life events can shape their development. This unit is coursework based and is internally assessed.
- Component 2– Health and Social Care Services and Values. This unit looks at how individuals act in a care situation and how to treat and communicate with the people you may care for in the future, including clients, patients and their families and friends.
- Component 3– Health and Well being. This unit looks at how individuals can stay healthy. This includes looking at diets, Health Campaigns and lifestyle choices. This unit is externally assessed via a set task. Students will receive the task set by Edexcel then be given time to prepare their answers in controlled conditions.

This is a specialist work related qualification which helps to build up practical skills for work and/or further study.

It is the equivalent of one GCSE.
