- Students who do not achieve at least a grade 5 in English and Maths GCSEs are likely to be required to continue to study these subjects post 16

Reformed GCSEs

- Introduced over three years from September 2015
- Graded from 9 to 1 (9 is the top grade)
- Linear courses with exams at the end of year 11
- More demanding content and less non-exam assessment

There are four options pathways, which are designed to suit and meet each individual student's needs. All students must follow one of,

- EBacc plus Triple Science and STEM enrichment
- EBacc
- EBacc Plus
- Non-EBacc.

Option Pathways

There are four option pathways:

Ebacc plus Triple Science and STEM enrichment – This option offer is tailored to support breadth and academic success for students with a particular interest and aptitude in the Sciences, Technology, Engineering and Maths (STEM)

EBacc – This option offer is tailored to students who want to secure the EBacc with the flexibility to study a wide range of subjects. It is suited to students who have a secure grounding across the range of subjects in Key Stage 3

EBacc Plus – This option is tailored to offer additional support to help students to secure the EBacc. Students opt for one subject less, which provides time for additional support in the EBacc subjects. It is suited to students who have a developing grasp of the subjects studied in Key Stage 3.

Non-EBacc with additional English and/or Maths – This pathway offers support to students who may prefer a less traditional route through Key Stage 4. It offers greater flexibility in subject choice alongside additional support in English and/or Maths.

Ebacc plus Triple Science and STEM enrichment

- French or Spanish (or another approved language)
- Geography or History
- Triple Science/STEM enrichment
- One further subject choice

EBacc

- French or Spanish (or another approved language)
- Geography or History
- Two further subject choices

EBacc Plus

- French or Spanish (or another approved language)
- Geography or History
- EBacc subject support sessions
- One further subject choice

Non-EBacc with additional English and/or Maths

- French or Geography or History or Spanish
- Additional support sessions in English and/or Maths
- Two further subject choices

- Based on the school's progress and other data for each student, they will be guided to consider an appropriate pathway
- These are included on each student's personalised Options Choice Form

How to Use SIMS Options Online

Step 1 - Receiving your invitation

You will receive an email from noreply@sims.co.uk titled 'Queen Elizabeth's Girls' School invites you to SIMS Parent', which will look something like the screenshot below:

You're invited to start using SIMS Parent to manage your child's personal details at Queen Elizabeths Girls School. If enabled by the school, you can also view child's attendance, school reports, homework assignments and more.

Simply accept this invitation and register within 90 days.




Initially, we will only use SIMS Parent for options, but you will notice mention in the email of other features, which are not currently available at QEGS.

Step 2 - Setting Up Your Account


Click on the 'Accept Invitation' link. This will ask you to login via one of the various options available as shown below. The only one that will <u>not</u> work is the <u>SIMS ID</u> option.



The first screen will be where your details are confirmed (your name and invitation code will show here automatically):



On the second screen you will be asked to confirm your daughter's date of birth for authentication purposes:




Step 3 - Signing In

When you log in you will see your daughter's recommended pathway.





Pathway: Ebacc


