Duke of Edinburgh Bronze Award 2018-19

Your daughter has expressed an interest in taking part in the Duke of Edinburgh Bronze Award for the 2018-2019 academic year.

The Duke of Edinburgh Award is a fantastic opportunity for girls to gain vital skills such as problem solving, team work and resilience. There are four key sections to the Duke of Edinburgh Award; the expedition, physical activity, volunteer work and learning a new skill. In order to complete the Award, your daughter must complete all of these sections.

As a school we do help the girls complete the four sections by offering clubs for them to join and volunteering opportunities, however, ultimately it is their responsibility to complete the individual sections.

The expedition training (10th March 2019), practice expedition (5th – 6th May 2019) and final expedition (6th-7th July 2019) are led by an outside company (A-Z Expeditions). The total cost to take part in the Award is **£300**. A **non-refundable** deposit of **£100** (£20 will be refunded if your daughter later decides not to continue). The deposit must be paid by **Friday 7th December 2018**, to secure your daughter's place on the expedition and to pay the Duke of Edinburgh Award registration fee. The remaining amount of **£200** can either be paid in a one off full payment or in monthly payments on WisePay, by the **1st February 2019**.
