A Level Results Day 2020

Dear Parents, Carers and Students,

As the summer term progresses, we are gradually receiving more information and guidance regarding this year's results days and how these will be arranged. It has also been announced that an exam series in the Autumn term will go ahead in order to provide an opportunity to sit an exam, should you wish to. Results Day will go ahead on the original date Thursday 13th August 2020.

A Level Results Day this year will be different from previous years. Students will be able to choose either to come to school to collect their results in person or to receive them by email.

Students coming to the school site

For those students coming onto the school site we must implement the current social distancing guidelines set by the Government. To minimise risk and ensure that everyone on site is able to maintain 2 metre social distancing at all times we will follow the procedures below:

- Results can be collected from 8.00am until 11.00am on Thursday 13th August.
- There will be a one way system in operation for entering and exiting the site.
- Anybody accompanying students to school will not be allowed on site. This is to minimise the number of people on the site and ensure that social distancing can be adhered to. We ask that you arrange to meet students at the Gordon Way exit which is from where the students will leave the site.
- When students arrive on site via the Meadway gates they will be required to queue, maintaining social
 distancing. When queuing, students must use the traffic cone markers and keep a 2 metre distance. We
 realise it may be tempting to break social distancing when students see each other but they must remain 2
 metres apart at all times.
- There may be a wait before students are able to collect results and we ask for patience during this time.
- The results will be issued in the Sports Hall and there will be hand sanitiser stations placed at various points in the process.
- Results will be set out on tables in alphabetical order by surname.
- All staff members that are in contact with and handing out results will be using appropriate PPE.
- Once students have their results there will be the opportunity if needed, to speak to a member of the Sixth Form Team for further support this will take place in the Sports Hall. Please refer to the information sent out previously on planning for A Level Results Day.
- We understand that collecting examination results can be an emotionally charged experience. We ask that for everyone's safety, students refrain from making physical contact with anyone while on site.
- Students will exit via the gates on Gordon Way where they can meet with anyone accompanying them.



Deciding whether to come to school or receive results via email

We ask that students let us know whether they intend to come to the school to collect their results or whether they would prefer to receive them by email. A 'Google Form' will be sent to students' **school email accounts** to collect this information. The deadline for completing this form is Wednesday 15th July and we require that all students provide this information. If these options are not suitable for you, then please email sixthform@qegschool.org.uk by Wednesday 15th July 2020 to make alternative arrangements.

If students choose to receive their results by email and require further guidance on Post 18 choices, a member of the Sixth Form Team will be available from 11.00am - 3.00pm. Students will need to email sixthform@qegschool.org.uk to request a telephone call.

Finally, as we have said previously, we do appreciate that Year 13 students have not had the opportunity to celebrate the end of their Sixth Form journey with friends and staff due to the nationwide lockdown. When it is safe for us to do so we look forward to arranging a celebration event and will contact all families with the details.
